<b>PREP</b>	PCMX or Chlorxylenol to face and donor site (thighs or abd)
<b>DRAPING</b>	Head sheet, 1000 drape, 4 paper sticky drapes, split sheet, towels, custom ENT pack #315360

<b>SOLUTIONS   IRRIGATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>[2] 15ml BSS with blunt tip needle or cannula for rinsing fat</li> <li>plain saline</li> </ul>

<b>LOCAL ANESTHETIC</b>	FOR FACE: 0.5% lidocaine w/ epi 1:200,000 50cc, [1] vial buffered with NaBicarb, Fill [2] 10cc/27g and [4] 3cc/30g FOR FAT DONOR: Mix 50/50 0.5 % lido w/epi and 0.5% Marcaine Fill [1] 20cc/22g spinal - NO BICARB
<b>MEDICATIONS</b>	Hurricane topical dental paste [in cart] 0.5% lidocaine w/ epi 1:200,000 50ml buffered w/ NaBicarb 5ml 0.5% Marcaine w/ epi 1:200,000 50ml vial NaBicarb 8.4% add 1ml to each 10ml local lidocaine
<b>STERILE SUPPLIES</b>	[4] long cotton tip applicators [8] Telfa 4" x 3" [2] 15ml BSS eye irrigation
<b>SPONGES</b>	[2] 4 x 4 Raytec
<b>SET TO OPEN</b>	<b>Dr. C MINOR SET and 2 Mayo stands</b>
	On mayo stand: place two raytecs and 1 telfa into separate piles for filtering and cleansing fat.
<b>INSTRUMENTS</b>	05 fine Adson forceps
	Straight tenotomy scissors small curved snap smooth Webster needle holder No. 11 scalpel Freer elevator Coleman aspiration & infiltration cannulas w/ transfer connector and glass flask → Dr. Cuadros to bring
<b>SUTURE</b>	[1] 5-0 plain P-3 #686 [hold]
	[1] 6-0 prolene P -1 #8697 [hold]
<b>DRESSINGS</b>	crushed ice in cooler, Bacitracin ointment
