

## 430 EVACUATION HEMATOMA FACE

This is an emergency operation done for bleeding and hematoma after a facelift. It is almost always done under general anesthesia at the main OR

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	<p><b>ANESTHESIA NOTES</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Accordion extension</li> <li>✓ straight connector</li> <li>✓ long circuit</li> <li>✓ regular ET tube</li> </ul> <p>Bed will most likely be turned 180 degrees.</p>
	<p><b>PATIENT POSITION SETUP</b></p>	<p>SCD's, pre-warm bed with Baer hugger Position patient bed flat, pillow under knees</p>
	<p><b>ROOM SETUP</b></p>	<p>[3] Mayo stands, [1] large back table Bovie machine, Dornoch suction at corner of room bipolar foot pedal taped to floor after bed turned ✓ Normal OR table in normal position, rotate <i>180 degrees</i> after induction.</p>
	<p><b>EQUIPMENT</b></p>	<p>Headlight w/ [2] light sources, [2] white hydraulic pump up stools</p>
	<p><b>PREP</b></p>	<p>Chlorxylenol (PCMX), 4x4 sponge box - <i>do not add water</i>. Prep lightly to face, eyelids, forehead, neck, hair</p>
	<p><b>DRAPING</b></p>	<p>Head sheet w/ 2 towels, 1000 drape, split sheet</p>
	<p><b>CAUTERY</b> note [4] tips</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Valleylab flat short silver tip (E1450-X)</li> <li>✓ Megadyne pencil tip (0013A)</li> <li>✓ Safe-t-Vac, ✓ [2] holsters, ✓ Bovie 20/20 pure</li> <li>✓ Disposable bipolar cord (#10-4001), Bipolar setting @ 10</li> <li>✓ insulated Bayonet bipolar forceps or Silver light</li> </ul>
	<p><b>SUCTION</b></p>	<p>[2] blue 3/16" suction tubing for Saf-T-Vac &amp; Yankauer, Dornoch suction machine</p>
	<p><b>SOLUTIONS   IRRIGATION</b></p>	<p>[3] liters NS irrigation, [2] Asepto syringes, [1] saline bowl</p>
	<p><b>NEEDLES   SYRINGES</b></p>	<p>[2] 10cc syringes on [2] 25g needles [2] 16g angiocath [2] 30cc syringes ➤ for Gwen irrigation</p>
	<p><b>LOCAL ANESTHETIC &amp; SOLUTIONS</b></p>	<p><u>Marcaine</u>: 0.25% w/epi 30cc on [2] 10cc syringes with 25g needles</p>
