PATIENT POSITION SETUP	Child on OR table. If patient small, lower foot. Close head gap <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Shoulder roll ● Large round gel headrest. ● Lower body Baer hugger ● 4" Coban if hair is long
TABLE POSITION	Will turn table 180 degrees
ROOM SETUP	Pre-warm bed and room 70 degrees
EQUIPMENT	Dr. C headlight with [2] light sources, [2] hydraulic pump-up stools

LOCAL ANESTHETIC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1% lidocaine with epi (in 3cc syringe with 30g needle) ● Pediatric mixture (in 10cc syringe with 1¼" 27g needle): mix 0.5% Ropivacaine with 1% lidocaine w/ epi ● If adult, use Marcaine 0.5% instead of Ropivacaine
MEDICATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Kefzol for irrigation, 500mg/500cc ● Bacitracin ointment 2 oz ● Methylene blue in blue cup on field
