<b>PATIENT POSITION   SETUP</b>	Child on OR table. If patient small, lower foot. Close head gap <i>If adult</i> - <b>ASK</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Terry cloth towel roll under shoulders</li> <li>● Large round gel headrest.</li> <li>● Lower body Baer hugger</li> <li>● 4" Coban if hair is long, girls</li> </ul>
<b>TABLE POSITION</b>	Will turn table
<b>ROOM SETUP</b>	Pre-warm bed
<b>EQUIPMENT</b>	Dr. C headlight with light sources, hydraulic pump-up stool
<b>SPECIALS</b>	methylene blud
<b>PREP</b>	Technicare to entire face and both ears
<b>DRAPING</b>	Head drape, 2 towels, 1000 drape, split sheet, basic pack
<b>CAUTERY</b>	<u>Tips:</u> Colorado tip [open], Valleylab silver coated flat [hold], Megadyne needle tip 0018 [hold] <u>Settings:</u> 10/10 pure. Holster.
<b>SUCTION</b>	[1] Suction and tubing, 7 fr Frazier tip suction (no Saf-T-Vac), mini - Yankauer
<b>SOLUTIONS   IRRIGATION</b>	Saline, Blue bulb syringe Kefzol irrigation, 500mg/500cc
<b>NEEDLES   SYRINGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● [2] 3cc syringes with 30g needle (for lidocaine w/epi)</li> <li>● [2] 10cc syringes with 1½" 27g needle (for mixture)</li> <li>● 20cc syringe with #16g angiocath (for Gwen irrigation)</li> <li>● [6] 1" 25g needles for tattooing</li> </ul>
<b>LOCAL ANESTHETIC</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 1% lidocaine with epi (in 3cc syringe)</li> <li>● 0.5% Ropivacaine (in 5cc syringe) for peds</li> <li>● Pediatric mixture (in 10cc syringe): mix 0.5% Ropivacaine with 1% lidocaine w/ epi</li> <li>● <i>If adult</i>, use Marcaine 0.5% instead of Ropivacaine</li> </ul>
<b>MEDICATIONS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Kefzol 25mg/kg IV</li> <li>● Kefzol for irrigation, 500mg/500cc</li> <li>● Bacitracin ointment 2 oz</li> <li>● Methylene blue in sterile cup on field</li> </ul>
