Benadryl 25mg PO Q 6 Hours PRN itching

Benadryl 12.5mg IV Q 6 Hours PRN itching

Bacitracin ointment: one ounce tube to bedside

Please have at bedside:

Disposable blue chux, box 4x4 gauze, 500cc saline irrigation, 3"x18" petrolatum gauze  
suture removal set, Bacitracin ointment tube

Pulse oximeter

O2 via NC or blow by to keep O2 saturation > 95%

Wound care: as directed
